The Friends of Flight 93 National Memorial (Friends) are awarding funds to school districts within Western Pennsylvania to support transportation costs to Flight 93 National Memorial. Regional school districts are encouraged to apply for transportation funding to visit the memorial and participate in PA standards-based educational programming developed for grade levels 4-12. This funding is available thanks to generous grants from Pirates Charities and the Pittsburgh Penguins Foundation. The Flight 93 National Memorial Learning Center is a classroom where teachers, students, park rangers and volunteers explore the story of Flight 93 and September 11, 2001. Programming launched in 2016 with 658 fourth grade students participating in a pilot program. In 2019, over 8,000 students were educated at Flight 93 National Memorial on the story of Flight 93, the memorial's design and importance in society, as well as how the youth can utilize the ideas of leadership, democracy and tributes within their own lives and communities.

After the education program takes place, bus invoicing must be billed to the Friends. Invoices must include a cover sheet with payment information and instructions for Friends' staff to process grant funding to bus company vendors.

Application for a transportation scholarship does not guarantee financial assistance will be available for your group. Only groups with documented approval prior to date of visit will receive transportation scholarship payments.
